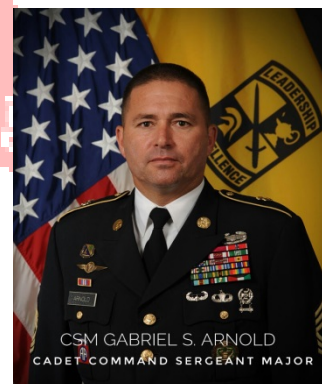


# ARMY CHAIN OF COMMAND
