

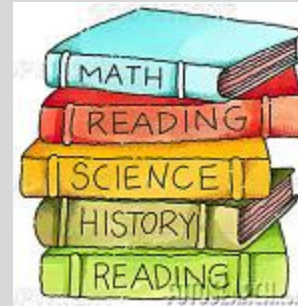

- In order to pass an annual class, you must earn 10 points. Five of those points have to be earned in the 2nd semester. To pass a semester class, 5pts must be earned.

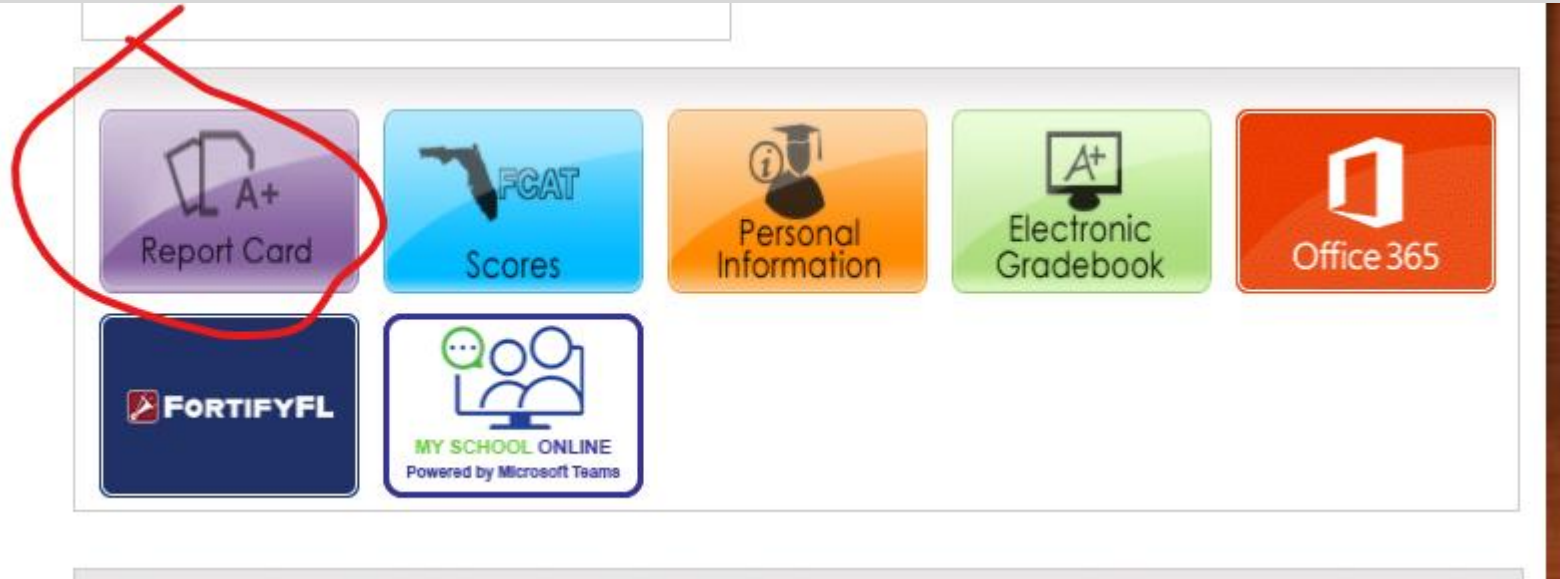



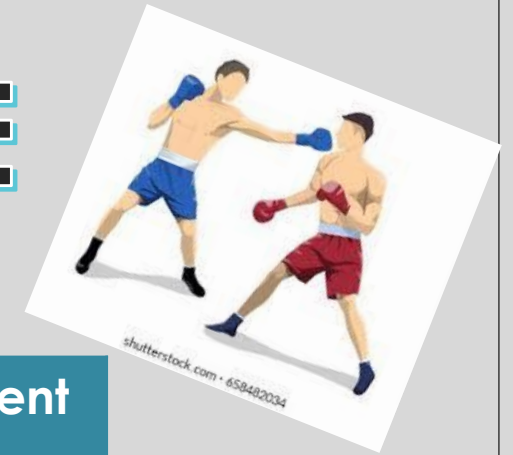
