


Reminders



- Professional Services




Processional

- Once the processional begins, you must conduct yourselves in the manner appropriate for this event.
- Follow the faculty member to your row. Choir and band members will walk in with their academy but will continue walking down the aisle to the band/choir areas to be seated.
- REMAIN STANDING!
- You will remain standing for the Pledge of Allegiance & National Anthem. You will not sit down till instructed to do so.
- Gentlemen will remove their caps for the Pledge



Diploma Time

- Each row will be instructed to stand when it is time to receive diplomas.
- Wait for a Faculty Member to instruct you to stand and move to the next location.
- Make sure you have your reader card!
- Pay Attention!



On Stage

- The graduate will receive diploma cover before going on stage.
- Will stand at the end of the table for picture with the principal.
- There will not be any hand shaking with the principal.
- No inappropriate gestures or behavior.
- Walk to the opposite end of the stage.
- Proceed to the end of the stage.
- Have picture taken again.

Back To Your Seat

After your picture has been taken:

- Immediately walk around to the center aisle
- Return to the side you came from.
- Move all the way down to the next empty seat.
- Stand and then be seated once the
- entire row has filled in.

It is OK if you are in a different seat when you return.

Recessional

- When the ceremony ends and the recessional music begins, graduates will exit when cued by faculty ushers toward the rear – LAST ROW FIRST. Do not exit your row till told to do so!!
- Graduates will walk out of the Miami-Dade County Youth Fair & Exposition Venue #1 and head directly towards their cars.

Diploma Pick-Up

In order to receive your diploma, you will need to:

- Come to SDSHS on June 10th 2021.
- Hours: 9:00 am 12:30 pm. Front of the school.
- Deposit your gown in the boxes provided at the school.
- If the gown is not returned, you will not be able to pick- up your diploma.
