Frequently Asked Questions

What is a Community Service Project?

Community service projects are planned, organized and voluntary efforts designed to address a problem or need in the community. The community service project you choose to do should also reflect your personal interest or skills. You must select a **non-for profit** organization and not earn any wages.

What Types of Projects Meet the Requirement for Graduation?

You may do a variety of projects to meet the Graduation requirement. You can spend time with senior citizens at an assisted living facility, tutor elementary or middle school students, work in a homeless shelter or soup kitchen as well as other community oriented activities. Your projects should be completed in the community and there should be no monetary award for your services.
