## What are the benefits of the IB Programme?

- Provides a broad general education while still allowing in-depth study
- Encourages students to appreciate cultures and attitudes other than their own
- · Encourages students to be informed, tolerant, and willing and able to communicate with others
- · The programme's international acceptability allows for both flexibility and mobility
- IB courses are recognized as excellent preparation for college
- Students who complete the IB programme have higher acceptance rates at colleges and universities
- Students can earn enough credits to begin college as sophomores, depending on the university
- 100% Florida Bright Futures Scholarship (Florida Academic Scholar Level)- Includes Tuition, Books, and even during Summer Semesters Requirements:
- Completed Algebra I and Physical Science or Biology in Middle School
- Maintained a 2.5 unweighted Grade Point Average (GPA) in the core academic subjects
- Do not have more than 10 absences, including tardy

## Components:

- Students study concurrently: Three subjects at Higher Level (HL) (240 hours each). Three subjects at Standard Level (SL) (150 hours each)
- English Language and Literature
- Foreign Language (Spanish or French)
- · History or Philosophy
- Environmental Science and Sports and Exercise
- Math Applications and Interpretations
- Elective (Dance, Visual Art, Film, Theater, History or Philosophy)
- All three elements of the core (Extended Essay; Theory of Knowledge; Creativity, Action and Service).
